## New Sermon Series: Launching Rockets!

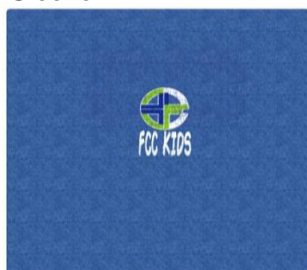

### BAKED PORK CHOPS COUNTRY STYLE

6 lean pork chops	½ c. raisins
6 med. size potatoes	2 T brown sugar
6 med. size onions	2 c. hot beef stock (canned bouillon will do)
6 med. size apples, cored but not peeled	salt and pepper

Brown chops in roasting pan in hot oven (450°) for about 10 min. Remove roaster from oven. Arrange potatoes and onions around chops; stuff apples with raisins, sprinkle with sugar, and place an apple on top of each chop. Pour hot beef stock over all. Roast 1 hr. at 375° or until vegetables are tender. Season to taste.
