We have a few exciting changes on track and I hope you will love all of them...

- The Sign-Up Sheet features an opportunity to “adopt” prizes for each booth. You can see the prizes and how much they cost for a particular booth. You can opt to purchase the prizes yourself or simply place the dollar amount for those prizes in an offering envelope and we will purchase them on your behalf. - We have a few booth changes from our “traditional” ones and hope they will be popular. We will be changing up our “popcorn” booth and doing “sno cones.” We are changing our traditional photo booth and making some props and signs and will be letting everyone use their phones and their own cameras to take photos. We look forward to everyone posting photos on social media with #allin and #fccfallfest. We hope to see some crazy, funny photos!

- We have brainstormed some new ideas for our door prizes and will be shifting from our traditional bikes to some light-up scooters, skateboards, Hatchimals, LOL balls, Ziggles and much more. We’ve polled the kids and heard that these are the “hot items” this year!

- We will be having people enter for a \$100 Walmart gift card to be given away at our Nov. 4 Worship Service. Everyone who attends Fall Festival will be entered to win and those first-time visitors who return on Nov. 4 will get a second entry. You must be present to win.
