FCC receives grants for upcoming Thankful Fest

FCC Guthrie was the recipient of a \$500 grant from the Oklahoma Disciples Mission Fund in the spring of 2020. The grant request was made on behalf of the Outreach Team and their 2nd annual Thankful Fest (tentatively scheduled for Nov. 8, 2020) and would be used to purchase an outdoor screen and projector for the event.

In June, we were contacted about applying for an additional grant for this event through the Faith in Action Commission of the Christian Church in Oklahoma. The grant request was made to the Reconciliation Grant Fund for events addressing pro-reconciliation and anti-racism in our society. With a quick turnaround, FCC applied for this additional grant and received the award in the amount of \$2,300 in early August! These funds will allow us to further our vision of a direct mailer inviting those living within a one-mile radius of our church grounds to attend our event. We are excited about the opportunities that await us as we continue to grow this event.

Kidventure

Kidventure is coming! We are planning a great and fun Kidventure for this fall with some changes to help keep everyone safe and adhere more closely with CDC guidelines. We are planning to kick off this fun fellowship on Wednesday, Sept. 16 from 3:30 to 5 p.m. We'll have a snack, play games and have lessons all centered around the Bible teaching that day! Kidventure is for those kids who are 5 years old through 6th graders. For this session of Kidventure, we are not able to offer school pickup. The kids must be dropped off at the church for Kidventure. If you'd like to coordinate rides with other Kidventure attendees on your own to get them to Kidventure, that is great. We will also be trying to keep the Kidventure groups in smaller numbers but cannot guarantee that we will be able to keep a 6-foot distance between the kids at all times. The way that our building is set up just does not allow for a complete 6-feet of distance for each child. We will have hand sanitizer available and will encourage the use of it frequently. Our activities will be designed to have less contact than we typically do but supplies will still be shared amongst the group. If you have any questions about the safety measures in place, please give Natalie Hardin a call and we can talk through them. The link to sign-up your kids will be emailed out when it is finalized. As with every program offered right now, we will only have Kidventure if it is safe to do so. In the event it seems to be a health risk to gather in such a large group of kids with so much personal interaction, we may have to temporarily suspend our Kidventure program until it is safe to meet again. If this happens, I will be in regular contact with Kidventure parents to update them if our plan needs to change.

Kidventure is already a program that needs a lot of adult help to help make it successful, safe, and super fun! This session we will need even more "hands on deck" to try to keep everyone healthy while learning and having a great time. If you are available to help with Kidventure for even one Wednesday (or several) we NEED you! Please get in contact with Natalie to arrange dates that you are available. Kidventure cannot happen without our amazing volunteers and we have a volunteer spot just for your talents! We can work around any scheduling conflicts or dates you have that you are unavailable. We have volunteers who help lead the groups to their lessons and we also have volunteers who lead the lessons and interact with the games and activities. There are plenty of opportunities to find a place where your talents are served best! This is a great way to get to know the kids in the church and have fun with them!

The notecards are all digital as well and offer more specific prayers on topics such as leadership, anxiety, parenthood, etc. These cards are to be placed around your home or office as reminders of what you are praying for each day. Both, the workbook and notecards are digital downloads. Of the two products, I would recommend the notecards.
