Kid's Worship - Week 3 – I can talk to God about anything (Ask, Seek, Knock – Matthew 7:7-12)

This Sunday, we covered talking to God about anything. God loves to hear us talk to Him, and He wants us to tell Him anything and everything. Our Bible story talked about a story Jesus told about a door and how our prayers should be like knocking, that we should keep praying and asking until that door (or prayer) is answered. Jesus promised that when we talk to God, He will answer. He may not answer right away, but that doesn't mean He's not hearing us. Part of our Bible story also taught us that we shouldn't wait until we want or need something to pray. We should talk to God to thank Him for good things that have happened too and we can tell Him that we are sorry if we need to also. We can talk to God about anything!

This week: Talk to your family about things you've asked God for and if there was a time that you waited a really long time for Him to answer your prayer.

Pray with your family: Use our P.R.A.Y. plan to pray with your family this week.

- Praise: Hey God, I praise you for...
- Repent: Hey God, I'm sorry for...
- Ask: Hey God, will you please...
- Yes: Hey God, I want what you want for me!
