### **KID'S WORSHIP**

I can talk to God Anywhere (How Jesus and His Believers Prayed – Luke 5:15-16; Mark 1:35, Matthew 26:36, Acts 12:1-17)

Jesus is the best example of how to pray everywhere we go! Even though He is God's Son, Jesus made sure He got quiet to pray and spend time with His heavenly Father. Summer Time is right around the corner and even though life still has some different obstacles, we are looking ahead because we know God is making a way. If God's way includes the youth serving others this summer, then here's what we are planning! An exciting week in Waco, TX organized by YouthWorks, "Teenagers need to encounter Jesus outside their normal context to deepen their faith and broaden their perspectives. Plus, communities need to be valued-not as mere recipients but as partners who have stories worth sharing in. When we bring the two together, incredible things happen." - YouthWorks website. You can check it out at YouthWorks.Com. On July 11 - 16 our group will have the opportunity to partner with a variety of social service organizations meeting on-going community issues. These include partners who come alongside education initiatives with children, those serving the homeless, and those with disabilities. Also in the evenings, we will get to explore downtown Waco, attend a local church service, and celebrate the week with new friends. YouthWorks is working with and listening closely to Service Partners when determining the safest and most respectful ways to serve this summer. They will be making some adjustments as needed. We might experience things like...

- Smaller service crews.
- Serving only with your own group.
- Updated vehicle or transportation guidelines and requirements.
- Specific guidelines for engaging with community members.






How it works:
