Kid's Worship: When I Follow Jesus, I Have Mercy!

Bible Story: A Sinner is Saved (Luke 19:1-10)

On Sunday in Kid's Worship, we continued our lesson series to learn that when we follow Jesus, we can become more like Him! During our time together yesterday, we learned about mercy. We learned that mercy means when you don't have to pay for the wrong things you've done. We heard the story of Zacchaeus. Zacchaeus was a tax collector who stole lots of money, but Jesus still wanted to come to his house and spend time with him. Jesus showed Zacchaeus mercy and because of that, Zacchaeus returned all the money he stole plus more! Jesus also shows us this kind of mercy and because we can be just like Him, we can show others we know mercy too!

This week: Talk to your family about a time that you showed mercy to someone. Discuss if it was easy or difficult for you to do, if you struggled with that decision, and what it felt like to be more like Jesus, and how you needed to show mercy.

Memory Verse to work on: "Your word to me, your servant, is like pure gold; I treasure what you say." Psalm 119:140

Pray with your family: Jesus, thank you for showing me mercy! Help me to show mercy to others too. Amen!

Kid's Worship Extra (KWX):

On Sunday, our Kid's Worship Extra kids shared a small meal to help reenact the last supper and then talked about the correlation between the events of the Old Testament story in Exodus of the Passover and how it relates to Holy Week and the sacrificial "lamb". The kids are going over the events that led up to Holy Week and how the days all culminate to Jesus dying on the cross and rising again three days later. The next time this group meets will be Palm Sunday, which begins Holy Week. Then, they will continue to cover these significant days and what they mean to us as Christians.

This week: Talk to your kids about the meal they shared in KWX on Sunday. Ask them questions about what the Last Supper was and why it was important. Discuss how Jesus might have been feeling during that meal together.

Easter Lílies


