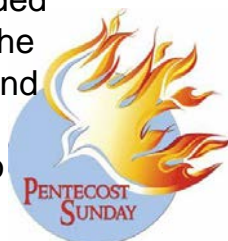

God is a Promise Keeper! Bible Story: Abraham (Genesis 12-17)

On Sunday in Kid's Worship, we learned that God is a promise keeper! God always kept His promises in the past, He keeps them in the present and He will keep them in the future. We learned about the story of Abraham, Sarah, and their son Isaac. Isaac was born after God had made Abraham and Sarah a promise. God kept His promise that He made to Abraham a long time ago, and He keeps His promises to us today as well. We can even trust that God will keep His promises in the future!

This week: Discuss with your family a promise that God has made you. Talk about if it was a promise from the past, present, or future. If God has kept His promise to you, talk about that with your kids. If you are still waiting for God to keep His promise, you should also discuss that as a family and explore ways you are still patiently waiting for that promise. **Memory Verse** to work on: "For Your kingdom is an everlasting kingdom. You rule throughout all generations." Psalm 145:13 **Pray with your family:** God, we thank you that you always keep your promises. Help us to remember your promises when we are facing something hard. We love you! Amen.
