

VBS Update



Kid's Worship (ages 4 yrs thru 2nd grade) - God Promises to Hear My Prayers - Bible Story: A Wise King (Kings 3 & 4)

On Sunday in Kid's Worship, we continued our unit on God's promises and learned that God promises to hear our prayers. We can pray to Him about anything and we can trust that He can hear us. In the Bible there was a man who prayed to God, God heard his prayer and answered it! God answered Solomon's prayer by giving Solomon wisdom. God promises to hear our prayers, too. We know that we can talk to Him anytime, anywhere, about anything!

This week: Practice praying with your child. Talk about times you pray and why those times of day are best for you. If you need some help, just look at your hand for a guide! Thumb: Pray for those closest to you, like your family. Pointer: Pray for those who point you in the right direction. Index (tallest): Pray for those that lead you. Ring (weakest): Pray for the weak or sick. Pinkie(smallest): Pray for yourself and your own needs. Try to pray each night this week with your family, using this 5 finger prayer as a guide!
