"The Best Gift Ever" - **Need to Know:** Jesus is God's Promise **Bible Story:** Jesus is Born - Genesis 2-3, Isaiah 7:14, Micah 5:2, Luke 1:26-55, 2:1-20, Matthew 1:18-25, 2:1-11

On Sunday in Kid's Worship, we started our Advent series! We started talking about all of the gifts that we want for Christmas, but the true best gift ever of Christmas was baby Jesus! We learned that God kept His promise to send Jesus. Long before Jesus' birth, God sent messages through prophets to remind people of His promise. One prophet named Isaiah had a message for God's people that a special woman would have a baby boy. Another prophet named Micah told people that the Savior would be born in a town called Bethlehem. God's people listened to God's promises and waited for God to send a Savior. Finally, after all of that waiting, God had a big surprise for a special girl named Mary who was engaged to a man named Joseph. Even though it was hard to understand, Mary remembered God's promises from long ago and trusted God's promise to her. All of this happened because it's exactly what God promised long ago! This was God's way of coming to be with His people. Because of Jesus, we can be friends with God forever!

This week: Keep discussing God's best gift ever, Jesus. As you are making Christmas lists, Christmas shopping, or just out and about, help your kids remember that baby Jesus is God's promise to us fulfilled.


