Need to Know: Keep our eyes on Jesus

Bible Story: Jesus and Peter walk on water - Matthew 14:22-23; Mark 6:45-52

Sunday in Kid's Worship we continued our series on the miracles of Jesus in the New Testament. God gave Jesus the power to do fantastic things so that those all who witnessed them would truly believe He was who He said He was, the Son of God! This week we talked about the story of Jesus walking on water out to the boat filled with His Disciples. As Jesus approached the boat, Peter did not believe it was Jesus. He told Jesus that if it was Him to give Peter the ability to walk on water too -- and Jesus did just that! Peter had to keep his eyes on Jesus and trust Jesus though because when he didn't, he started to sink! We talked about what that could mean for each of us and how we can keep our eyes on Jesus too!

This week: Talk through some ways that you keep your eyes on Jesus throughout a regular week. Do you notice a change in your days? What happens when you take your eyes off Jesus? Do you start to "sink" like Peter did?

Pray with your family: God, thank you for sending your Son, Jesus, to earth for each one of us. Help us as we try to keep our eyes on Jesus and put our trust that You will help us through whatever seems scary.

Our nursery ministry is currently available to families during the 10:30 am Sunday service and as needed for other church events and ministries. The nursery serves children from infancy through age 3. A nursery coordinator is needed to oversee this ministry, be the welcoming face each Sunday to church members and guests alike, expand a rotating monthly schedule of care providers, develop a volunteer rotation, and provide safe, secure, nurturing, clean, and efficient care to our infants and toddlers. We are looking for an individual who loves little children and who can make them feel safe and loved during their time with us. The nursery coordinator works closely with the Children's Minister and other church staff on visioning for the program and meeting the church nursery needs. This position is an hourly position at the rate of \$18 an hour. Nursery Coordinator will record their time worked on a time sheet and use their time wisely and productively to complete and improve the tasks required.
