Ronnie's Report

Since December 2017 we have partnered with Water4, an Oklahoma based ministry, and raised over \$4000 to help provide sustainable clean drinking water for people in Africa. Someone recently asked me for an update as to what is happening with Water4. While they are constantly working on various projects, I found this recent update especially inspiring. Here are a few excerpts from it.



Water4 and their partners are empowering women through access to safe water and employment. Here is the story of one of those many women they have helped. Meet Claudette: Claudette is a NUMA water station attendant in Nyarufunzo Village outside of Kigali where she's worked for over two years. The job has not only changed how her community sees her, but also how she sees herself. Claudette used to work basic and menial jobs like fetching water for people and selling things on the street, but her new job as a NUMA attendant has given her financial security and improved her status in the community.

Water4 also installed a well at Mutumbi Village that is serving almost 3,000 people. Mutumbi is located about 9 miles northeast of Bunia in the Democratic Republic of Congo.

Also, don't feel like you have to have a "family" to do these meals. These meals are great for "singles" who enjoy eating leftovers and can be split into several meals. BRAINSTORMING...

As we start preparing for fall, I have been meeting with several different teams – Connections, Outreach and Christian Ed. and one of the things we have been brainstorming is Fall Festival. This past year, we celebrated our 14th Fall Festival and as we began discussing this year's event, I challenged all of those committees as well as our staff to consider if this event is still serving the purpose, we want it to serve. As a congregation, I want to get your feedback as well. I love the excitement and crowd that Fall Festival has brought to our church over the years but also don't want to keep doing the same thing year after year just to keep doing it.

Many of you spend time donating supplies, volunteering and supporting this event and I never want to take for granted the energy you put into this ministry.

As we start to consider the number of similar events in town at that time of year and what other ideas we could explore, we are open to different ideas and would love your input. One idea that seems to be gaining some ground is a parking lot event earlier in October that could involve hayrides, an outdoor movie (short movie that plays often), cookout-style food, Smores, haymaze, a few games, free-throw contest, dunk tank, etc. Thoughts at this point is that it would allow families more free time around Halloween and allow us to market the event to our "neighbors" and do more specific inviting. One of the targets we have identified in Christian Outreach is to be more aware of our "church neighborhood" and how we are "reaching out" and "touching lives" within the 2- to 4-miles radius within our church reach.

While we always strive to meet needs wherever God calls us, just as those serving in Jamaica this week or throughout the city of Guthrie, the state or wherever, it has become apparent that sometimes we fail to see that our "neighbors" are just a few steps away.

Anyway, be thinking, as we are in the next month how we can make "Fall Festival" the most effective event possible. If the consensus is that it needs to remain as it has and improve it from there then we will do it in that form, but if we need to be more fluid and find ways to increase the visibility of it; make it less hectic for families and freshen it up then we will work to make those changes as well. Please share your thoughts!

Along that same line... we are looking forward to our leadership retreat on Aug. 25. This is a chance for the Board, Elders, Team Leaders and Staff to gather and look at a vision for the next six to 12-months. If you have ideas, thoughts, concerns you would like us to discuss during this time, please visit with Ronnie or I prior to that meeting.
