We are needing a few more volunteers to get this class moving forward. If we have enough volunteers you would only be expected to lead the class twice a month. On Sunday, we announced a new approach to our **Bereavement Team Ministry**. This has been a long-standing ministry of our church and one of the most respected and appreciated ministries our church offers to families in their time of grief. It is also one of the ministries that allows many individuals to participate and offer their time and talents.

As a result, we have heard over the past several months how many are wanting to be involved but aren't sure how to become a part of this ministry. With that in mind, we are expanding our Bereavement Team Ministry to include more people and also lighten the load on those who are currently serving.

We will be expanding to three serving teams who will rotate as meals are needed. What this means is that you have an opportunity to sign up for a team to serve on the day of a meal by working in the kitchen or dining room and will only serve when your team's rotation comes up. Also, for those who aren't available during the daytime, we have slots for those who could bring a dish – salad, dessert, casserole or whatever is needed. The casserole category is a new addition, as some of the teams have suggested we might try serving things like broccoli/cheese casserole, potatoes, green bean casserole, etc. instead of our tradition green beans and corn.

Our goal is to make this ministry as wide and encompassing as possible and there has even been a suggestion to always have in mind the attitude to make a little extra at the meals and be able to deliver a meal or two to a shut-in, someone coming home from the hospital, or just bless a busy family or surprise someone with a meal following a dinner. Wouldn't it be amazing to see this ministry blossom into something bigger than it already is!?!

Our goal is to streamline this process so the same people aren't having to serve at every meal and more of our congregation can be involved! We look forward to this ministry continuing to be a blessing to families.


