Kid's Worship - Need to Know: I Can Wonder About Heaven

Bible Story: Heaven

Bible Reference: John 14:2-3, 14:6, Revelation 21-22, Matthew 8:11, Isaiah 65:25, 2 Corinthians 5:1-7, 1 Corinthians 2:9

On Sunday in Kid's Worship, we continued our wondering about Heaven. We heard the story again about John and his glimpse into what Heaven would be like. We watched a fun science themed video all about how while we don't know exactly what Heaven will be like and just how awesome it will be, we can get an idea about some of it from our Bible story all about what God showed to John about Heaven.
