Kid's Worship - "The Best Gift Ever" **Need to Know:** Jesus is God With Us

Bible Story: Jesus is Born

Bible Reference: Genesis 2-3, Isaiah 7:14, Micah 5:2, Luke 1:26-55,

2:1-20, Matthew 1:18-25, 2:1-11

On Sunday in Kid's Worship, we continued our lessons about the best gift ever...JESUS! God sent Jesus, who is also called, "Immanuel," to be with us. Jesus came to earth, lived the perfect life, died on the cross and came back to life! And when we choose to receive the gift of Jesus, we can be friends with God and live with Him forever one day in heaven!

This week: Talk to your kids about just how crazy it was that Jesus was born in the barn; try to help them compare that to how babies are born today. Jesus, who is God with us, was born where all of the animals lived! Discuss that even this part of the story is not typically how anyone would expect our Savior to arrive, but that it happened just as God promised it would!
