Capital Campaign Update

On March 15, 2020 we kicked off a 3-year Capital Campaign to replenish the funds we had recently committed for a roof replacement needed over a significant portion of our church building. A week later, our world experienced chaos, shutdowns, illness, and more – clearly not the time to be kicking off such a lofty campaign.

However, over the past 26 months, we have successfully raised \$125,671 toward our \$200,000 goal – and we aren't done yet. We have 10 months remaining to raise an additional \$74,329. This may sound like a lot, but the faithfulness of this congregation has always persevered. We continue to operate with a balanced budget and \$0 in debt! This Capital Campaign is not needed to pay off an current commitments, but to ensure that if a major building repair were needed, we would have the funds to do so.
