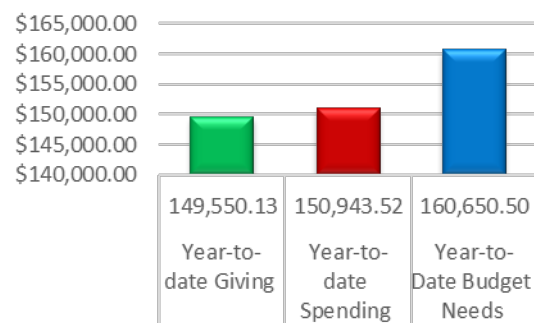

Are you looking for ways to get involved at FCC?




Recently, our Bereavement Dinner Team and our Meal Ministry Teams have been very busy! There are a number of ways to serve on these teams. Our Bereavement Teams handle dinners for families who have lost a loved one. These meals are typically held before or after a memorial service and give the family time to enjoy eating together and reflecting on the loved one who was lost. It has been a long-time ministry of the church and one that is treasured by families. There are multiple ways to help: providing a side dish such as a salad, vegetable or dessert; helping set-up for the meal with tablecloths, drinks, paperware, etc.; helping serve the meal which is typically buffet style but helping keep the line stocked and drinks made; or helping clean up following a meal. If you could help in any of these ways, we typically text or e-mail out when a need arises and those that can help, sign up! It's super easy to connect to this ministry.

We also have a meal ministry for those who have come home from the hospital after an illness or surgery. We typically provide 3-4 meals for the family and they can be homecooked or purchased. We provide a list of favorite foods and allergies/dislikes. We try to do meals every other day so as not to overwhelm the family with food. Typically, meals are a main dish, side, bread and dessert. For this ministry, we also do a text or e-mail when a need arises and those who are able to help sign up for a day to make and deliver the meal.
