In March of 2020 we kicked off a 3-year Capital Campaign to replenish funds used to replace our outdated boiler and failing roof. The goal was to raise \$200,000 over 3 years as we prepare for the next equipment replacement - likely HVAC units over the Sanctuary end (most of the units are over 30 years old!)

We are now 6 months away from our end-date and about \$63,000 short of our goal! Please consider an extra donation to the Capital Campaign – no gift is too small!

• From the intersection of Division and Highway 33 (Noble Ave.) go approximately 3.1 miles west to Broadway (just past the hospital).


• Turn right (north) on Broadway and go 1 mile to where the road ends.
