A Note from Pastor Ronnie

As I continue to prepare for sabbatical, I wanted to share a few statistics with you, not to garner sympathy, but to help all of us understand the importance and benefits of a sabbatical. The average length a pastor serves a church is 4 years. 1500 pastors leave ministry every month, some never return to a church. Only 50% of pastors make it beyond their first 5 years in ministry and only 10% of pastors make it all the way to retirement serving the church. In addition, 42% of clergy



seriously considered leaving ministry in the last year. Only 33% of pastors report having a healthy marriage. Ministry can really take it's toll, but regular sabbaticals and rest can prevent that. I am thankful for the opportunity provided by First Christian and it's leadership to allow me the opportunity for a sabbatical.

My sabbatical will consist of 3 elements: personal renewal time, family renewal time, and study time. The first two weeks I will spend at a spiritual retreat center in Colorado Springs, CO. Then I will spend 4-6 weeks working through several online courses that will include direction in Leadership, Church Growth, Online Presence, and Preaching. I will spend the last three weeks on a trip with my family traveling along the eastern coast and up into Canada. I would ask that you pray for my sabbatical in these 3 ways: 1) My retreat time would bring spiritual rest, renewal and growth, 2) My time with family would be enriching, and 3) my study time would benefit the church when I return. If you have questions about sabbatical, please do not hesitate to ask.



Sabbatical Information

General Questions about a Sabbatical

What is a sabbatical?

The word sabbatical has its roots in the biblical concept of Sabbath ("to rest" or "to cease"). Sabbath keeping is setting aside time that God consecrates and makes holy.

Sabbatical leave is a time for a minister to shift gears in order to rest, study, reflect, and travel in order to return to minister among us refreshed and renewed in body, mind, and spirit. A study component is often included to enrich the ministry currently being served by the minister. (This is not a time for career assessment, or a job search).

Sabbatical is more than a vacation from meetings, budgets, sermons, and people in need. It is a time to receive spiritual nourishment and a change in perspective, to deepen one's relationship with God, self, and family – a time of spiritual growth. This time can also be seen as a season of growth for the entire congregation.

Do other clergy go on sabbatical?

Yes. Clergy across denominations take sabbaticals. Ministers return from sabbaticals with a sense of refreshment and renewal for ministry. Sabbaticals are a healthy way to prevent clergy burnout and extend the tenure of ministries in local churches.

How did Ronnie taking a sabbatical come about?

When Ronnie was called to serve as minister of First Christian in 2017, the letter of call included a sabbatical of three months following the completion of five years of service to the church. October 2022 was the conclusion of Ronnie's fifth year as senior minister of the church.

When will Ronnie take his sabbatical in 2023?

He plans to begin his sabbatical following worship on May 7 and return on August 7. The period is for three months. The desire is to take the sabbatical at the least programmatic time of the year.

What will happen during Ronnie's absence?

We have already filled in all Sundays for pulpit supply. The elders in conjunction with Karen will fill in for pastoral care.

How will the sabbatical time be paid for?

The church budgeted for pulpit supply in this year's budget.

What will Ronnie be doing on his sabbatical?

The sabbatical time will be divided with three purposes

- 1. Spiritual Renewal Time time for spiritual reading, deepening of faith, and time to refresh his soul
- 2. Family Renewal Time quality time with Shana and Max
- 3. <u>Study Time</u> selecting a study plan that will be of benefit to the church's future; the study component is intended to have a direct import back into the life of First Christian Guthrie
