

Easter is coming!

During Holy Week we will be offering the opportunity to walk a **prayer labyrinth** on Thursday and Friday (April 6-7) from 6 -8 p.m. We will have it set up in the Reception Hall.



What is a labyrinth? It's like a maze but with no dead ends. It is an ancient spiritual practice dating back thousands of years. A labyrinth is simply a place to walk and pray. There is nothing mystical about it. It gives you the freedom to walk around while focusing your mind on God — and not worry about getting lost. A labyrinth contains a single walking path to the center and then back out again.

How long will it take to walk it? That's up to you, take as little or as much time as you want in your prayer walk.

Will there be any guidance? Yes, we will have some examples of ways you can pray while walking.

Next Sermon Series after Easter

Our next sermon series will be "Disillusioned: What do we do with doubt?" and will begin April 16. I know many of us struggle with whether doubt is good or bad, healthy or unhealthy and we will be looking at Biblical examples of doubt and how Jesus and God dealt with it. To go along with the series we will be offering a special worship opportunity on April 26 at 6 p.m., a "Doubt Worship" if you will. You won't want to miss it!

In February, staff members applied for seven different grants, hoping for funding from monies available from the ODF. All of the grants received partial funding and many received the full amount! We are so grateful to the ODF for recognizing the important of our ministries in the Guthrie area.

The grants received include:

- \$1,037.50 Esther in Branson, Esther Bible Study
- \$1,000 Microphones/Equipment for Musicians
- \$500 Kidventure
- \$600 Lunch and Learn
- \$500 Food for the Soul (meal prep with an evangelism aspect) Our grants totaled \$6,937.50!

Also happening this Sunday is our **Kid's Palm Processional**! This Sunday, April 2, is Palm Sunday and to recognize and celebrate this day, we will have our own palm processional through the church to symbolize that day when Jesus entered Jerusalem riding on a donkey. Now, we don't have any plans to ride any donkeys this year but we will have palm branches that the kids will wave while parading through the sanctuary with shouts of "Hosanna!" If your child would like to be in the processional, please plan to meet in the reception hall directly across from the sanctuary at 10 am. We will do a quick run through of our processional route so everyone has an idea of the plan and then collect back into the reception hall to line up until it's our turn to enter into the sanctuary during this worship service. 
