

Keeping Up With Karen



We've been preparing for several months and the time is almost here! Time for Sabbatical! What is a Sabbatical? It is a period of paid leave granted by the church for the Pastor to renew and refresh. Per his contract, Ronnie is eligible for a Sabbatical every five years. During this time he will spend time focused on spiritual renewal, study and connecting with his family. All of these are things that sometimes get pushed aside when caring for the needs of a congregation the size of FCC Guthrie.

How can you be supportive?

Prayer! Pray for Ronnie, his family and for our church. Pray that he will find a sense of renewal and at the same time the church will continue to thrive in his absence.

Be present! So often when a pastor takes a sabbatical, congregates may feel like it's a good time to "skip" church as well. Please know that your presence is noticed! For example, on Easter we had 360 people in attendance, which was amazing! The week after, we had 135 in worship. This past Sunday, we had 267. I can assure you as a staff member when attendance fluctuates by 100-plus on any given Sunday, it is felt not just by the staff but by those who are in attendance.

Actively seek ways to be involved! While Sunday morning attendance is important, so is being available to serve and be a part of activities that are going on. The staff will be working normal hours (and extra hours) but often times for events we need more hands and extra donations. Be aware of things listed in the "News and Events" that need volunteers or things that are mentioned on Sunday morning. For example, because I will be doing a lot of the worship service, I will be unavailable to teach Kid's Worship Extra with Staci. There are also some Sundays she needs to be in worship (Graduation, Promotion Sunday, etc.), so we need volunteers to help with that 3rd-6th grade class. Specific dates we need help are May 14 (2 volunteers needed), June 25 (1 needed), July 9 (1 needed), July 23 (1 needed). For Kid's Worship we need help on June 25 and July 9 when Natalie is unavailable.

That is just one example of help we will need. All ministries will continue as they usually do so VBS, meal ministry, Bible studies, Mission Sunday, Dinner Groups, funeral dinners, etc. will all continue as usual. So, be ready to jump in when needed and you can always call the church office to see if there are any pending needs.

Do's and Don'ts

- Do be present and active
- Don't "go on vacation" from church. We recognize that Summer is a vacation time and know you will be gone from time to time, but if you're in town come join us!
- Do Keep Giving! We have been on a great trend financially and have been doing more and more ministries! Let's keep the momentum going!
- Don't keep concerns to yourself. If something doesn't feel right or isn't going right, we need to know! The worst scenario is to let a problem/concern go until Ronnie returns and then dump things on him when he returns. It would so quickly undo any of the "renewal" he received.
- Do INVITE! Just because the Pastor is gone, Evangelism doesn't stop. The church is not one person. People need to know the love of Christ through all of us. Our message is always relevant.
- Don't Call Ronnie thinking that "one phone call or text" won't hurt. We have a very capable staff and are happy to help and if we can't answer your question or help, we will find someone who can. We have tons of resources available.
- Do Be positive! Giving your Pastor a sabbatical is a sign of a very healthy church. It means we want our Pastor to not lose his passion for serving and even more exciting it shows that we are truly the Body of Christ and our church functions in his absence. The church is EVERYBODY sharing Christ and growing in faith!


FCC Baptism Shirts for sale!
