

Scriptures: Joshua 2; Matthew 25:14-30

ARE WE ON THE RIGHT TRACK? Ladies and gentlemen, boys and girls, welcome to the *Promised Land Grand Prix!* Buckle up and check your engines as we'll be racing through the life of Joshua and the Israelites!

AND WE ARE OFF... During Youth Extra, we read about how God can use everyone! The Bible story of Rahab is a great example of someone the world might define as unworthy but God knew her heart!

If you want to race into this story, try these questions...

- SCRIPTURE QUESTIONS
 - Who did Joshua send to Jericho and why? (Joshua sent two spies to look over the land.)
 - What did Rahab do to protect the spies? (She hid them, then told the king's messengers that they went in a different direction.)
 - Why did Rahab help the spies? (She believed in the God of Israel and hoped the Israelites would rescue her when the time came.)
 - o Read Matthew 25:21. What do you think it means to be "good and faithful"?

PIT STOP (Weekly challenge): Every racer needs to take a pit stop to stop and refuel. Ask yourself:

- I know that **God can use someone like me**, but what might that look like?
 - o Think of someone who taught you something.
 - O Think of someone who helped you out before.
 - o Think of another someone who encourages you and makes you feel great about yourself.
 - Think of someone else whom you would turn to if you were in any kind of trouble.
- These are people that were *used by God* to do those things for you. If they had shrugged their shoulders and decided to pass on the opportunities, you might not be where you are today. We can't see God, but God gives us people we *can* see to show us what it looks like to love and care the way God does. So when you allow yourself to be used by God, you get to help someone know a little more about God!
- How can you give THANKS to someone whom God used to help you?

PRAYER: God, thank you for people like Rahab, who had faith and trusted in you. Help us to be on the lookout for ways you can use people like us, too. We know that no one is too small or insignificant to you. Amen.
