
Connections Team Update

What a fantastic Sunday we had with so many different highlights! I have heard so many joyful comments about all the people who "officially" joined our church family on Sunday. Some of these families have been coming for quite some time, while others are fairly new. It is exciting to be a part of a growing church and one that focuses on inviting new people.

Also exciting, these past few Sundays we have hosted Pastor's Class and with 24 attending it has been a room full of learning, great questions and excitement as some of them prepare for making their Confession of Faith, Baptism and others explore their faith further. Their questions have been good and have made each of our ministers think about "Questions Kids Ask" and how relevant this current sermon series is for each of us. It's easy as adults to be afraid to ask questions or feel embarrassed when we don't know something but I can assure you that you are not alone in your questions. As we tell the kids, we don't have all the answers but we are excited to explore the questions together. If you're wondering what some of the questions the kids asked during Pastor's Class entail, how about things like:

- How do you know if someone who has died is in heaven?
- How do I hear God?
- Is God male or female?
- How do I tell someone about Jesus?
- Did Jesus have brothers and sisters?
- If someone never hears about Jesus, can they go to heaven?
- How long did it really take to create the world? Was it just seven days?
- What does God look like?
- How old was Jesus when he died?

At the end of each Pastor's Class session, we played "stump the Pastor/Associate Minister." It was fun to hear them ask questions that were on their hearts and minds. I hope that "asking questions" continues beyond our discussions with children and that as adults we explore the questions that rest on our hearts and cause us to pause. It's never wrong to ask questions and seek good answers; hence why our mission statement is: "Sharing Christ and Growing in Faith."

Coming up....

Our nominating committee will be meeting in the next couple weeks. If you aren't familiar with who they are, it is a committee that brainstorms how to fill the various serving roles within the church. They contact and reach out to people to be part of the Church Board, Elders, Deacons, Team Leaders, various committees such as Pastoral Relations, Trustees, Scholarship Committee, etc.

Please be in prayer as this committee meets – pray for wisdom in who will fill roles this coming year (our church serving year runs from July-June; financial church year is Jan.-Dec.); pray for ways you are called to serve and let us know that you are willing to step up and be a part of all that is happening.

God has placed each of us in this church family for a reason. We are called to serve in different ways and equipped with many talents. Please be in prayer about what you are called to do — it's fair to say most of us are "busy." I would challenge if we are "busy" doing things that matter and make a difference for His kingdom. I am so excited to see where God takes us next!
