

Youth Ministry

Youth started this week with some pickleball and the theme: God gives us directions to follow... Adonijah Tries To Be King. 1 Kings 1:5-14, 29-35 and James 1:19-25 - these were read and discussed. Our Memory Verse: James 1:5 "If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to you." We all need directions to follow. They can be signs to avoid danger in a construction zone, advice from grown-ups to keep us safe, or recommendations from friends for a book to read or a movie to watch. These can all be great directions to follow sometimes, but there's someone who gives us directions that we should always follow...God! Do you think it would be cool to be a King? Just because you want something and think it would be great doesn't mean you should just do it. Adonijah knew what he was doing was wrong and that it was going against God's plan. That's probably why he didn't even tell his dad, King David, about it. King David was determined to follow God's directions because he knew following God is always the wisest thing to do. How much trouble would Adonijah have saved himself and everyone else if he had simply followed the clear directions from God? His story serves as a reminder to all of us not to ignore what God is telling us but to follow the directions God gives us. God gives us directions to follow. When God's son, Jesus, was on earth, he showed us how to follow God's directions. He taught everyone what it meant to obey God's commands and demonstrated it through his actions. Jesus was both a listener and a doer!




