Veteran's Recognition & Wreaths Across America

This Sunday, we will celebrate Veteran's Day by recognizing all those who have served in our armed forces. In addition, we will have a special guest who will briefly share about the "National Wreaths Across America" project that is happening in Guthrie this year. The program is designed to decorate every Veteran's grave with a wreath at Christmas. It is \$17 to sponsor a wreath and they will be put on graves at Summit View Cemetery on Dec. 14. Currently, there are 1,586 known veterans buried in Summit View. Guthrie is one of nine locations across the U.S. that "Wreaths Across America" is doing this year. Our loose change offering for November (collected Nov. 24) will go to this project.






