Spring is here! We are quickly moving into the next season as we continue to prepare our hearts for Easter. Palm Sunday is April 13, and Easter is April 20! We can't wait to celebrate Jesus' resurrection with our families! On Palm Sunday, we will have our palm processional with the kids entering the sanctuary waving palm branches and shouting praises of Hosannah to start the worship service that morning, so make plans to be here early that day if your child wants to participate in that. Easter Sunday will of course be extra special, and we will have special Easter lessons, activities, and games in each of our KidMin classes that day too!

# APRIL what we're'= teaching this month

Spring is the season for new beginnings! Whether you're cleaning out parts of your home or watching the flowers bloom in your garden, it's a time for new life and growth. Like a good gardener, Jesus wanted to help cultivate the seeds of faith in his friends so they could all grow closer to God. In this 4-week series, kids will learn all about the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus as he sowed the seeds of new life in the world. Kids will discover that God sent Jesus to save us, Jesus understands when we're hurting, makes all things new, and connects us to God.

### MEMORY VERSE:





Easter is coming! Hopefully you are preparing for that exciting Sunday as we journey through Lent. Ronnie's sermon series, "Famous Last Words," has been fantastic and if you haven't caught the first two sermons, take a moment to get on our Facebook page (First Christian Church of Guthrie) or our website (www.fccguthrie.org) and get caught up! It will be time well spent. It is so powerful to think about the last words Christ spoke as he was on the cross and paying a debt he did not owe. I can't even fathom what it would have been like to be at the cross that day. I have been watching a video series on the YouVersion app called "8 Day Video Bible Plan" that features 2-3 minute videos of the journey to the cross. Monday's video showed how Jesus was beaten and whipped and made to carry his own cross. It showed how the crown of thorns was placed on his head and those that ridiculed him. Then, in one short clip, it shows his mother standing in the background watching it all happen. For whatever reason, in that moment, I just sat there thinking "what would I have done?" As a mother to two boys, I can't even fathom watching all that happening and having to allow it. For my son to walk the path to the cross and be accused of things that he never did. Those days between Palm Sunday and the resurrection must have been excruciating for those closest to Him.

This Easter, you are going to have an opportunity to fully embrace the emotions of Holy Week. We will end Palm Sunday's service (April 13) in a special way that prepares us for the journey to the cross. On Thursday and Friday, we will have the sanctuary open for a Prayer Vigil. If you have never participated in a Prayer Vigil, this is a time where the sanctuary will be open for prayer. You can sign up for a 30-minute time slot or just drop by and spend time praying quietly in Sanctuary. There will be an Elder or Pastor on duty in the entryway so you are not alone in the building. There will be a few stations to visit if you wish including communion and a few other meaningful activities. We will have music playing softly to help you focus. You can do the activities or just simply sit in silence and meditate/pray. In the past, I have had people tell me that this is one of the most powerful times they have experienced in their faith. I hope you will consider signing up for a time slot or stopping by and experience time alone with God.

#### A FEW OTHER THINGS...

This Friday, Saturday and Sunday we will have a Rummage Sale to benefit our Mission Trip to Jamaica. The trip attendees will be working the sale to earn money toward the cost of their trip. Each participant is paying \$2,000 to go on the trip, where they will serve from July 5-12 in the St. Mary Parish. We will also have a Bake Sale to help benefit attendees. If you can bring an item for us to sell, that would be great! We will need them by Thursday at 3 p.m. Please make plans to come and shop to support our youth and adults who are traveling this Summer.

Last but not least, the deadline for Summer Camp is approaching. If you have a student who will complete 1<sup>st</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grades this school year, we would love to have them join our Camp! It will be June 16-20 (June 16-18 for those who have completed 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> grade).


Our food pantry is located at: 1402 E. Cleveland. You are welcome to drop off items there or bring them to the church and Sadie Porter will take them to the pantry.
