Camryn and Carson Ireton made their Confessions of Faith and were baptized on Sunday! We are proud of you!

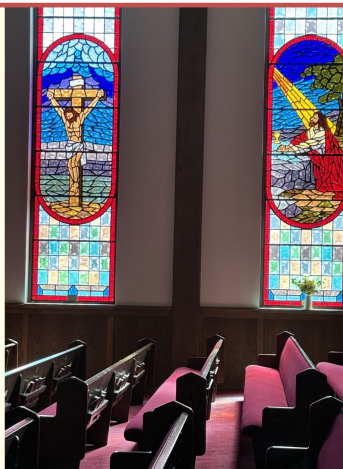

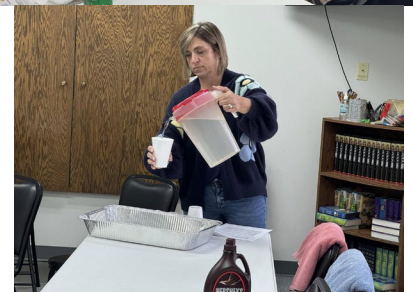
